RE: RELEASE OF JULY/AUGUST 2026 ASSESSMENT TIMETABLE, AMENDMENT WINDOW, AND PAYMENT OF ASSESSMENT FEES

The TVET Curriculum Development, Assessment and Certification Council (TVET CDACC) wishes to inform all Assessment Centers that the July/August 2026 Assessment Timetable has been released and is now available on the portal. Institutions are advised to access the timetable and confirm that all registered units of competence have been appropriately scheduled.

Further, the portal has been opened for amendments and late registration to allow institutions to register candidates who may have been omitted during the initial registration period and to correct any errors in candidate registration details. Assessment Centers are strongly encouraged to thoroughly verify all candidate

information, registered units, courses, and assessment cycles to ensure accuracy. The amendment and late registration window will close on 26th June, 2026, after which no further changes will be allowed.

The Council also wishes to notify institutions that the deadline for payment of assessment fees has been extended to 8th July, 2026. Institutions are advised to complete all payments within the stipulated period to facilitate smooth assessment administration. Kindly note that only institutions that have fully paid the assessment fees will be allowed to participate in the July/August 2026 Assessment Series and access assessment tools. Assessment Centers are therefore urged to take advantage of the amendment window and ensure all registrations and payments are completed within the prescribed timelines.
