IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPETENCY BASED EDUCATION AND TRAINING (CBET) MODEL

Reference is made to the Principal Secretary's letter Ref: MOE/VTT/2/45 dated 26th July, 2023; directing that all admissions to Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) institutions in September 2023 be on the Competency Based Education and Training (CBET) curricular. However, intelligence reaching this office indicates that some Principals have not implemented the CBET curricular as expected.

The Kenya Kwanza administration is looking at Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) as the sub-sector that is key to providing skilled manpower needed to spur industrialization in our Country. The Government expects technical, vocational education and training (TVET) institutions to equip the youth with requisite skills that will enhance employability by reducing the gap between learning to earning.

The Government has put in place the necessary legal and regulatory framework. This includes enactment of the Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Act No. 29 of 2013; enhancement of TVET infrastructure across the country; and has continued to enhance training capacity through recruitment of more trainers.

In the foregoing, it is directed as follows:

- o That all Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) institutions embark on implementation of the Competency Based Education and Training (CBET) curricular without further delay; and

- That all Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Agencies support this directive by providing the needed facilitative and technical support.

It is further directed that the State Department for Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) will provide this office with regular briefs on the status of implementation through quarterly reports.
